Make learning fun

Children learn best during play when the learning experience is exciting and interesting for them.

Fun learning tips

- Set aside some time. As little as 5 minutes can make a difference.
- Take time to play with your child, focusing on activities that they enjoy. If the activity is enjoyable for them, they will be more likely to want to play and interact with you.
- Follow your child's lead: Look at what they are interested in and show that you are also interested in that item or activity. If they are losing interest, move on with them or take a break.
- Use lots of facial expressions and make your voice sound excited!
- Be face to face with your child. Don't be afraid to get down on the floor with them.
- Remember to Watch, Wait, Listen.
- Relax and have fun!

Try these at home

- Spend time observing your child.
- What activities/toys do they like? What do they go to first?
- Try to come up with a **list of activities** that they find highly motivating and engaging.
- Limit distractions at home. For example turn off television and radio.
